Zombie tower defense games

With its touch controls, the iPad is a natural fit for strategy games. Here we round out the best. Whether you're a fan of turn-based or real-time strategy, tower defense or rogue simulations, you'll find something to love in any of these great iPad games. XCOM: Enemy Within can be the first PC or console game to receive a full port to iPad. This is great news for strategy buffs who know XCOM as one of the most beloved strategy games of the decade. Complex turn-based tactics provide unprecedented depth of strategy, while the backdrop to an alien invasion offers a disturbing sci-fi experience. Enemy Within is the expanded version of the original game, Enemy Unknown. It includes everything from the original, as well as new themes and game elements. One of the most famous (and addictive) strategy games of all time, Civilization allows you to build a thriving empire that faces time, history and nature alike. The sixth installment, Civilization VI, is the first to reach iOS and includes a virtually identical port of the PC version. Players familiar with previous editions of the game know what to expect: an expanding, empire-building, turn-based monstrosity from which it's hard to get away. Beginners, however, can find the complexity difficult to navigate. Civilization VI comes with a considerable price tag, which is understandable given the similarity to the PC version. But you can demo the game up to 60 free turns. Inspired by Star Trek, FTL: Faster than Light is a rogue game, which means there is a degree of randomness generated by procedures in each new game. With so many different ways to play the game, you'll find yourself exhausting hours at the command of your own starship. If you've ever wanted to know what it's like to command a red T-shirt, knowing full well what a red T-shirt means, this is the game for you. First launched in 2004, Rome: Total War beautifully combines turn-based and real-time strategy with tactical control of military battles and campaigns. Rome: Total War is one of many classics to enjoy a renaissance on iOS, without losing any of the magic that made it a great strategy game to start with. Packages include the classic Rome: Total War, the barbarian invasion and Alexander variants. Each can also be purchased separately. Civilization Revolution is an attempt to bring the Civ franchise back to its roots, simplifying massive gameplay into something casual and hardcore strategy players can enjoy. Civilization Revolution has the same epic feel as PC games, with hours of content but in a simpler package. The sequel, Civilization Revolution 2, expands this with new technologies to discover and units to deploy. There's also a new way to play: the scenarios, which drop you right amid simulated historical events. There is no doubt that Civilization VI is the ideal, large version, but it also has a large price tag. If you're not familiar with it Civilization games, Civilization Revolution 2 is a great way to wet your feet before jumping into the more complex Civilization VI. Plants vs Zombies was a refreshing version of the tower defense strategy game, and the sequel stays true to its roots. It is perfect for players who enjoy the addictive quality of strategy games without the need to spend hours in a single session. Levels become more intense as you progress, and you'll be able to play through different themes, such as wild west and Ancient Egypt. This is one of those rare occasions when if you've never played the original Plants vs Zombies, the sequel is the best place to start. The free model, which in other games can swarm ads and in-app purchases, is tolerable here. The original is great, but you'll still have a bit of fun if you decide to play through the sequel first. Difficult to pronounce, but easy to become addicted to, Rymdkapsel is perhaps the most unique game on this list. The goal is to build a space station capable of preventing alien attacks while investigating some strange monoliths. Some people may be turned off by minimalist graphics, but these graphics yet evoke a charming atmosphere. In many ways, Rymdkapsel is reminiscent of the old Dungeon Keeper games, where you build a dungeon with different rooms and prepare your minions to protect yourself from intruders. It's unfortunate that the Dungeon Keeper remake was too heavy with in-app purchases, but for players who like that combination of real-time strategy and tower defense, Rymdkapsel is a lot of fun. Designed for space science fiction fans, Star Command puts you in command of a spacecraft tasked with defending planet Earth. You have strategic control over the ship's operations and resources and can deploy red T-shirts to defend the ship. In addition to red T-shirts, there are yellow shirts that serve as engineers and blue shirts who are science officers. Retro graphics and the lighted version of the genre add fun to the experience. As you hold the ship, you'll face enemies that are transported to your ship. The only drawback of the game is the linear story, which makes playing through a second time a little repetitive. Perhaps the best tower defense game on iPad, TowerMadness will task you with the critical mission of defending sheep from an alien invasion. Your arsenal includes a tower that electrocutes aliens to make them run slower, an amplification tower that upgrades surrounding towers, and an artillery tower that bombards enemies. TowerMadness features a free-form tower defense game and an excellent tutorial that will quickly take you to the nutless game completely dull tower for a long time. For those who love a bit of role-playing in their strategy games, Battleheart puts you in charge of a lone knight, able to recruit more mercenaries as the game progresses. Intuitive sliding controls allow you to control on-screen action, making a unique, real-time hybrid RPG Experience. Modern Conflict has an intuitive one-touch control scheme that allows you to send tank battalions and helicopters against enemy bases without sweating. It's a good solution to some of the navigation issues facing other real-time strategy games. We just want the game to have fewer paywalls and ads. Great Little War Game has some familiar strategy elements in real time, but in a turn-based framework. You go around collecting gold and building troops as you would in a real-time game, but there's a need for complex strategy and planning that's more familiar to turn-based games. You are a lone soldier defending your castle from an avalanche of aerial and sea dragons. You start with a simple bow and arrow, but later you'll have the chance to get more advanced weapons. The game is quite simple: to aim the arrow, just aim at your target. The power of the arrow, on the other hand, depends on how you drag your finger across the screen, with the amount of drag that determines the power. It's a little confusing to explain, and it takes a little getting used to the game, but after a few levels it will be a pro.Completing a level earns you gold, which you can spend on upgrades and food. You will need food to keep your people alive; but if you manage to survive at later levels, a ship will automatically deploy from your fort and someone will collect dragon meat for you. So with each level you use food, but you'll also earn food (assuming your meat picker isn't killed). Upgrades include better weapons, more arrows, and a stronger fort. But these improvements are quite expensive, and you don't earn much gold in the first several levels, so the action of the game can take a while to collect. All in all, Dragon Hunter II is a decent tower defense game that finally becomes quite challenging and interesting, but eventually it's the key word here.
